USA Shooting mourns the loss of Hall of Fame inductee, Arthur Edwin “Art” Cook

COLO SPRGS, CO (March 1, 2021) – Arthur Cook, member of the USA Shooting Hall of Fame, 1948 Olympic Gold medalist, and two-time National Smallbore Prone Champion passed away on February 12, 2021. Our heartfelt condolences to his wife Mary and their family and friends during this time.
